The Bibione Project originated from the collaboration of the Institute of Classical Archaeology at the University of Regensburg, the Department of Cultural Heritage and Department of Geosciences at the University of Padua, as well as the Italian Ministry of Cultural Heritage.

The research project explores the architectural structures, the functions and the many roles of the Roman Villa of Mutteron dei Frati by collecting important data to reconstruct the ancient surrounding landscape in particular.
