## Call for Papers «Musica & Figura»

Musica & Figura (M&F) is a peer-reviewed, ANVUR-accredited journal published by the Department of Cultural Heritage of the University of Padua, in collaboration with the Ugo and Olga Levi Foundation of Venice.

M&F publishes original articles, case studies, empirical research, and reviews. Occasionally special issues dedicated to important topics in art and music will be published. Contributions may be written in Italian, English, French, German, and Spanish. If the author does not use their mother tongue, the contribution must be revised by a native speaker before being submitted to the journal.

M&F invites articles for the next volume, scheduled for publication within fall 2026.
